In this letter to the Corinthian church, the Apostle Paul is comparing the Christian life to an athletic competition. It would hit home for his hearers because Corinth was the site of the Isthmian Games similar to the Olympics. In these games several well-trained athletes competed for the prize, but there could only be one winner who would receive a pine wreath crown. However, those who faithfully complete the Christian life will receive an imperishable crown.

The race that Paul, and we too, are preparing for is the calling of God. Paul's spiritual training was the very best available. He continued to discipline himself and to follow his calling from God. We need to continue to discipline ourselves as well. Finally, Paul writes to Timothy (2 Timothy 4:6-8) "I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing."

Praise God, there is not just one winner as there was in the Isthmian Games! The crown of righteousness is for **all** who have loved His appearing! The crown is for **all** believers in Jesus. If you have not invited Him into your heart and life, today would be an excellent time to do it." Behold, now is the accepted time: behold now is the day of salvation." 2 Corinthians 6:2b
