May is Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Month. This is proclaimed by Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and ABATE OF Indiana. It is my hope that each of you will take a formal rider education course if you haven't done so. I have taken the course several times. Both of my daughters have taken the course. I guess you can tell I am an advocate. It is surprising the number of bad habits a Safety Course can point out. Also, statistics show that 90 to 95% of riders involved in crashes had no formal training, were self-taught or learned from family and friends.

Some of you may remember a television series that aired in the early eighties called Hill Street Blues. The Sergeant on the program prior to sending his police officers out on patrol each day would say "BE CAREFUL OUT THERE." It's really not bad advice for bikers either. When my mother was alive, she would remind me of that every time she saw me headed toward the garage.


Of course, no matter how careful a rider is, accidents can occur, usually through no fault of his or her own. Most motorists are law-abiding people who bear no animosity toward bikers. They simply do not see us because their eyes have not been trained to look for motorcycles.

In 1983, I was struck by a four-wheeled vehicle whose driver did not see my bright red helmet, my bright red jacket and my bright red bike. Fortunately, my large frame and

"natural" padding helped deter any serious injuries. I vaguely remember hearing the state trooper ask the driver when he first saw "the biker." Although it sounds impossible, the reply was, "I saw him when he landed on my windshield." It's an experience I pray the Lord keeps me from repeating.

Yes, life is fragile, and we do need to "Be careful out there!" I strongly advocate taking the Motorcycle Safety Course. However, even more importantly, I urge you to seek refuge and safety in Jesus. "Salvation is to be found through Him alone; in all the world there is no one else whom God has given who can save us." Acts 4:12 (Today's English Version)

The one event in May you should consider riding in is the Region 11 ABATE of Indiana, Shelby County, "Safety and
