Dear Friends,

While we are enjoying cool breezes, our thoughts and prayers are with all those who have been affected by the devastating storms in Texas and the Gulf. Just imagine how they are trying to find a clear road to safety.

Have you ever found yourself riding around trying to access a super highway being overcome with the feeling of helplessness as you ride under the freeway several times looking up at all those other bikes and cars traveling by and having no clue as to how to get on the highway! Many people go through this same kind of frustration spiritually. They see Christians living fulfilled lives. They have become convinced that Christ is the <u>Way.</u> They want to follow Him, but they don't know where to begin. Think of the outcome of those introductions! Andrew's brother, Simon Peter, was one of the greatest leaders in the New Testament. The Feeding of the Five Thousand was one of the greatest miracles! And one of the greatest statements Jesus made, when He saw the Greeks coming, "And, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself." John 12:32(NRSV)

We should all be **introducers** like Andrew. It is legitimate to be concerned about pushing those who are not ready, so we need to be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit. Witnessing is not our plan, but God's. We are not asking to enter the lives of other people, Jesus is. We are just His representatives. What a blessing to realize He is the evangelist; we are just the **introducers**. We can't convert anyone, but God can use us to lead people to Him. Jesus said, "No one can come unless the Father who sent me draws him." John 6:44

Being an **introducer** requires a combination of patience and expectancy. What a tremendous blessing to experience being on hand when God brings someone to Himself!
