It is impossible for a strong tree to have high branches without having deep roots. It would become top-heavy and topple over in the wind. The same is true with Christians. It is impossible for us to grow in the Lord without entwining our roots around His Word and deepening our life in His commands." To be like a tall immovable tree comes only through a life of Bible study, discipline and faith – conditions that produce deep roots.

Trees are also used in the Bible in reference to witnessing to our faith. "The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise." Proverbs 11:30
