Please go and encourage others to conquer any obstacle that lies ahead when they place their trust in Jesus!

God will let you see miracles in your life. He wants to see you grow in love and joy. He wants to use you to make a difference in the lives of the people in our motorcycle community. Confirm the status of all events before making plans to attend. Ride through life in love, hope and patience, trusting in God, and always being faithful in prayer. Please stay healthy and safe.
